


You helped 43 elders receive 284 acts of assistance related to

40 elders participated in 8 field trips and social events to reduce social isolation.





We were helping her with routine medical care when a stress test showed she was in need of emergency care. The attending physician couldn't believe she was walking based on the test results! She was rushed to an ER and eventually a pacemaker installed. Thanks to your generosity, Ciin is smiling and enjoying a full life.



Thanks to you and our partnership with the West End Home Foundation, you helped Zomi and Mindat refugee elders get out of their homes, enjoy each other's company, and see a few sites. They visited the Tennessee State Museum, the Governor's Residence, the Parthenon, and enjoyed playing BINGO at the Green Hills YMCA.

2023 IMPACT


High School Success



24 youth worked 20 hours a week in summer 2023 and earned over \$38,000 in wages. They developed practical skills such as cooking and car maintenance.

12 high school students participated in paid summer internships, gained valuable work experience, and developed leadership skills.

18 Lead Southeast High School students received mentoring and 897 hours of tutoring as you create better futures.





Special Opportunities

Nations Ministry continues to provide case management, immigration assistance, referrals, and rent assistance for Ukrainian families fleeing the Russian invasion.



Road to Citizenship

In calendar year 2023, Nations Ministry assisted 167 people with \$118,0785.87 of mortgage and utilities assistance for lowincome familes affected by COVID-19.



You helped newcomers move along the road to US citizenship! Refugees need help in navigating the complex immigration system. Recognized by the Department of Justice, Nations Ministry helped 360 people with their immigration needs in 2023.




184 citizenship applications 33 green card replacements and renewals

104 students improved in one life skill domain according to a nationally recognized testing instrument.




